- (f) Please make sure the entries you are making should be correct. No plagiarism is allowed and its strictly monitored, if found plagiarized the application stands cancelled.
- (g) Applications must be sent to <u>director.claws@gmail.com</u>, any applications sent by other means will not be accepted.
- (h) Text Promoting or referring to political party or religion will not be accepted.
- (j) All information is to be provided in English. Subsequently we propose to open the entries to other languages too.
- (k) Co-Presenters are not allowed.
- (I) Participants are requested to also bring a physical copy of their paper on the event day.
- (m) Participants must be aware that the Committee reserves the right to cancel their participation if they do not comply with these guidelines that will be sent at the end of the selection procedure.
- (n) Participants must be university students only.

- (a) CLAWS does not cover travel, accommodation and ground logistics costs, but participants will get welcome kit, refreshments and lunch.
- (b) Participants will be provided the necessary assistance to participants for presentation at the venue.
